

Bylaws -

Article 3 - defined by Chapter 33, Article 1 Agreement to remove language of the Ordinance from Bylaws. Agreement to post a link to City of Chelsea's City Board, Committee and Commissions Handbook and Human Rights Ordinance under the Human Rights Commission heading on the website.

Article 4.5 & 4.6 - As suggested by Council

Article 4.7 - As suggested by Council with the change from "Board" to "Commission"

Article 5.1 - Agreement to remove Code of Conduct with the addition of a link to the City Board, Committee and Commissions Handbook to the website under the Human Rights Commission heading.

Article 9 - Agreement that the HRC wants the ability to collaborate with the use of committees and has that ability in the conduct of regular Commission business to do so.

Article 11 (now 10) - Agreement that proposed amendments to bylaws should start with the Commission, approved by the Commission and forwarded to City Council for approval.

" These bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting by a three-fifths`vote of all voting members currently serving on the Commission. Proposed amendments must have been submitted in writing at the previous regular meeting of the Commission. Once approved by the Commission, proposed amendments will be sent to the City Council for review and adoption and will not become effective until approved by the Council."

Agreement to submit to City Council, on an annual basis, proposed plans for research and educational programs.

Request for Council liaison was explained and agreement by consensus from the City Council. No date was set for such an appointment.
