WINTER 2018 PROPERTY TAXES



2018 Winter Property Tax bills were mailed November 30, 2018 and are **due February 14, 2019 by 4:00 pm**. If you did not receive your tax bill, contact the Treasurer at 475-1771. Failure to receive your bill does not exempt the taxes from penalties. Winter taxes are payable to the City of Chelsea. CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP

The Department of Public Works will pick up Christmas trees and wreaths throughout the month of January. Trees and wreaths should be placed on the lawn extension. Please remove any wire, nails, and plastic from the trees and wreaths.



BRUSH PICK-UP SCHEDULE

Brush pick-up continues to be the second Monday of each month starting at 7:00 am. **Leaves must be bagged. Do not rake leaves into the street.** It typically takes all week for the crews to make one complete pass through the city.

SNOW REMOVAL

- * Snow and ice must be removed from sidewalks within 48 hours of snowfall (Ordinance No. 94)
- * Snow cannot be pushed onto the streets (Ordinance No. 94)
- * No parking on streets from 2:00 am to 5:00 am (Ordinance No. 84)
- * Violations can result in property owner fines

When shoveling your driveway and sidewalk, please remove the snow from around the fire hydrant common to your home or property. Clearing the snow around the hydrant and shoveling a path to it from the street will give the Fire Department the access they need.



FREE INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE

ANNUAL PROPERTY ASSESSMENTS

The City will mail all property owners annual property assessments in mid-February 2019. You can contact the assessing department with any questions during their on-site hours: Monday, 8:00 am to noon and Wednesdays, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. If necessary, you can also contest the values through the March Board of Review process.
