A presentation was given by the county road commission regarding regional road planning by Washtenaw County. Recently, the southwest corner of the county has collaborated to review road maps and determine where road right-of-ways could be established and where possible new connector roads may be feasible. The road commission would like to see similar discussions take place in the Chelsea area and all of western Washtenaw County.

Discussion took place on the possibility of M-52 being widened through downtown Chelsea and whether having historic designation may make this more difficult to execute.

Planning Commission members received copies of the draft county master plan and were assigned sections of this document to review and comment upon at the next meeting with the goal being a single prepared response from the commission by the August deadline for comments.
