

**RESOLUTION REGARDING  
POLICY ON ACCEPTANCE OF PAYMENTS BY FINANCIAL  
TRANSACTION**

WHEREAS, Act Number 266 of the Public Acts of Michigan of 1995 and Public Act 280 as amended, (the "Acts") authorize a local unit of government by resolution of its governing body to authorize acceptance of payments by financial transaction devices— for example, credit cards, debit cards, and electronic funds transfer—and,


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chelsea has determined that it would be convenient for and in the best interest of the City and its residents if payment to the City could be made by financial transaction devices,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Chelsea, Washtenaw County hereby approves and authorizes the acceptance of payments to the City of Chelsea by financial transaction devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager, Administrative Director, and Treasurer shall determine the types of financial transaction devices that may be accepted.
